

Prof. Dr. I Nengah Surati Jaya, M.Agr Talked About Spatial Modelling and Biosciences



Prof. Dr. I Nengah Surati Jaya, M.Agr (Faculty of Forestry - IPB, Indonesia) said that the Bioscience is the branch of the sciences concerned with living organisms, from microorganisms to towering trees and gigantic whales.
