Last year, based on AUN-QA assessment, Study Program in Biology has been <u>fulfilled</u> ASEAN University Network-Quality Assurance (AUN-QA) requirement. A year later, <u>Dr. Iman Rusmana M.Si</u>, former head of the Department of Biology, visit Vietnam to participate the Assessors Training Workshop for AUN-QA Programme Assessment (Tier II). He was able to attend this second tier of the workshop as he completed the first tier before.

In the event held on 6 - 12 December 2018, he and other participants experienced real assessment experiences by incorporating both classroom simulation at Hotel Nikko Saigon and real-time observation of AUN-QA Programme Assessment at Ho Chi Minh City University of Technology and Education.
